**Three 2',4',6'-Trioxygenated Flavanones in Roots of *Echinosophora koreensis*.**MUNEKAZU IINUMA\*, MASAYOSHI OHYAMA, TOSHIYUKI TANAKA,  
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Futher investigation of the phenolic constituents of the roots of *Echinosophora koreensis*, led to the isolation of 11 compounds. Their structures were determined as (2S)-6-geranyl-5,7,2',4',6'-pentahydroxyflavanone, (2S)-8-geranyl-5,7,2',4',6'-pentahydroxyflavanone, (2S)-6,8-di(*r,r*-dimethylallyl), 5,7,2',4',6'-pentahydroxyflavanone (kenusanone B), sophoraisoflavanone A, isosophoranone, 2,3-dehydrokieveitone, sophoracarpene B, sophoronol, pratensein, genistein and scopoletin. Three of them are novel flavanones possessing a 2',4',6'-trihydroxyl moiety on the B ring.

**Isoflavones from Roots of *Euchresta japonica*.**

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Seven new isoflavones named euchrenone b<sub>10</sub>-b<sub>16</sub> were isolated from the roots of *Euchresta japonica*. These structures were determined by the means of spectroscopic analysis. Furthermore, to clarify the position fused by a dimethylpyran ring on ring A, we also discussed the UV spectral data.

**Coumarin Derivatives in *Coptis trifolia*.**MIZUO MIZUNO, HIROYUKI KOJIMA, MUNEKAZU IINUMA\*,  
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Known compounds, epiberberine, groenlandicine, scopoletin and  $\beta$ -sitosterol were characterized in the whole plant of *Coptis trifolia*. By means of spectral analysis, the structures of two new compounds were determined to be glycosides of a 10-hydroxygeranyl residue which is linked with scopoletin through an ether linkage.
